

Consensus Protocol

The parties agree to the following protocol on days when schools are unexpectedly closed to students:

When an unexpected school closure occurs due to road conditions, and students are not required to be in school, teachers and administrators shall decide the most appropriate location to work that day and will not be subject to loss of pay should they decide to work at home.

Should a school (s) be closed to students for consecutive days due to road conditions, teachers may be responsible on the second or subsequent days for attending school or alternate settings for professional development opportunities, or other group activity, subject to appropriate notice (before 8:00 a.m.) and working conditions (Occupational Health and Safety Provisions).
