ORFF LEVEL I & II SUMMER COURSES IN NS AND PEI

July-August 2014

These two-week intensive courses in the principles and techniques of Carl Orff's *Music for Children* lead to Orff Specialist certification. The Orff philosophy of music education is an internationally recognized approach to teaching music in schools or group classes. In these courses, teachers learn to foster student performance skills, literacy, and creativity through carefully sequenced musical experiences using songs, games, rhythms, poems, dances, and stories from around the world. Participants receive training from specialists in recorder playing, choral techniques, movement, percussion instrument technique, and pedagogy.
